X/4 CS -- TITO, DADDAH DISCUSS CZECHOSLOVAKIA

MUNICH, SEPT 6 (CMD) -- YUGOSLAV PRESIDENT JOSIP BROZ TITO AND MAURITANIAN PRESIDENT MOHTAR DADDAH DISCUSSED THE CZECHOSLOVAK EVENTS IN THEIR OFFICIAL TALKS ON THE BRIONI ISLAND YESTERDAY.

THE MEETING WAS REPORTED BY RADIO BELGRADE TODAY. THE TALKS PASSED IN AN ATMOSPHERE OF COMPLETE FRANKNESS, FRIENDSHIP, AND MUTUAL UNDERSTANDING, THE RADIO ADDED.

THE AGENDA INCLUDED A NUMBER OF TOPICAL QUESTIONS FROM INTERNATIONAL LIFE, INCLUDING THE LATEST EVENTS IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA, IT SAID.

SPECIAL ATTENTION WAS DEVOTED TO THE BILATERAL COLLABORATION BETWEEN YUGOSLAVIA AND MAURITANIA, THE RADIO SAID.

THE EXCHANGE OF VIEWS WILL BE CONTINUED AT THE END OF DADDAH'S VISIT TO YUGOSLAVIA, WHEN HE AGAIN MEETS TITO ON BRIONI.
