X/4 C/S -- PRACE URGES UNITY AND CONFIDENCE

MUNICH, SEPT 6 (CMD) -- THE CZECHOSLOVAK TRADE UNION DAILY, PRACE, CALLED TODAY FOR THE FULFILLMENT OF DUTIES AT WORKING PLACES, LEST CZECHOSLOVAK LEADERS BE INTERNED AGAIN.

RADIO PRAGUE QUOTED PRACE AS SAYING THAT, AFTER THE DAYS OF UNSHAKEABLE UNITY, DROPS OF MISTRUST HAD BEEN ADDED THROUGH UN- - REASONABLE MEANS, AND THAT THE ROAD TO REPARATION COULD BE OPENED AGAIN BY MEANS OF UNITY AND CONFIDENCE.

"WE SHALL EXPRESS THAT TRUST BY THE FULFILLMENT OF OUR DUTIES AT OUR WORKING PLACES AND BY OUR MORAL SUPERIORITY. ONLY THAT WAY CAN WE PREVENT OUR LEADING REPRESENTATIVES FROM BEING INTERNED AGAIN, OR THAT OTHER IMMENSE LOSSES BE SUFFERED," PRACE SAID.

(UPI) - PRACE NOTED THAT IT HAD RESUMED PUBLISHING ONLY AFTER SOVIET TROOPS HAD BEEN WITHDRAWN FROM ITS OFFICES, AND SAID "OUR NEWSPAPER IS AGAIN IN THE HANDS OF THOSE TO WHOM IT BELONGS."

"TODAY, THREE QUALITIES ARE ESSENTIAL--CALM, COURAGE IN ORDER TO CHANGE THAT WHICH CAN BE CHANGED, AND WISDOM TO DISTINGUISH THE FIRST FROM THE SECOND," PRACE DECLARED.
