CS -- ZEMEDELSE NOVINY REAPPEARS

PRAGUE, SEPT 6 (CNR/CMD/UPI) -- THE AGRICULTURAL NEWSPAPER, ZEMEDELSE NOVINY, REAPPEARED TODAY IN ITS OLD FORMAT FOR THE FIRST TIME SINCE THE OCCUPATION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA BEGAN.

A LOCAL BOHEMIAN COMMUNIST OFFICIAL HAS TOLD ZEMEDELSE NOVINY THAT IN TALKS BETWEEN THE CZECHOSLOVAK POPULATION AND FOREIGN TROOP COMMANDERS THE VIEWS ARE "FUNDAMENTALLY DIFFERENT."

RADIO PRAGUE ATTRIBUTED THE STATEMENT TODAY TO A "COMRADE CISAR," THE LEADING SECRETARY OF THE DISTRICT COMMUNIST PARTY COMMITTEE IN BEROUN, SOUTHWEST OF PRAGUE, MADE DURING AN INTERVIEW PUBLISHED BY ZEMEDELSE NOVINY TODAY.

CISAR SAID THAT WHEREAS THE FIRST TROOPS DEMANDS ABOVE ALL CONCERNED THE MATERIAL SUPPLY, THE CURRENT DEMAND IS - FRIENDSHIP.

"THUS THE TALKS ARRIVE AT A COMPLEX SITUATION, BECAUSE THE ARGUMENT THAT THE RESTORATION OF FRIENDSHIP IS NOT RPT NOT IN THE POWER OF POLITICIANS IS MET (CMD: BY FOREIGN COMMANDERS) WITH MISTRUST," CISAR ADDED.

"REPRESENTATIVES OF FOREIGN TROOPS FOR INSTANCE ASKED WHO HAD GIVEN THE PEOPLE IN THE CITY THE ORDER TO REMOVE ROAD AND VARIOUS OTHER ORIENTATION SIGNS. THE COMMANDERS DID NOT RPT NOT BELIEVE THE ANSWER THAT NOBODY HAS DONE SO, AND CLAIMED THAT PEOPLE CAN NOT RPT NOT DO ANYTHING IF THEY DO NOT RPT NOT GET A UNIFORM ORDER," HE SAID.
