"AT THE SAME TIME," SZTANDAR MLODYCH CONTINUED, "RUMANIA WAS PUTTING OBSTACLES, AND CONTINUES TO DO SO, TO THE DEVELOPMENT OF ECONOMIC TIES WITH SOCIALIST COUNTRIES.

"FIGHTING FOR AN ALLEGED ECONOMIC INDEPENDENCE, AN ARGUMENT USED BY RUMANIA IN TALKS WITH HER SOCIALIST PARTNERS, SHE BECAME ACTUALLY DEPENDENT ON WEST GERMAN CAPITAL. IT IS A PECULIAR INTERPRETATION, INDEED, OF THE IDEAS OF UNITY AND SOLIDARITY."

SZTANDAR MLODYCH ALSO CRITICIZED RUMANIA FOR NOT RPT NOT HAVING BROKEN RELATIONS WITH ISRAEL LAST YEAR, WHEN OTHER COMMUNIST COUNTRIES DID.

"ON THE CONTRARY, SHE CAME INTO EVEN CLOSER CONTACTS WITH THAT COUNTRY," SAID SZTANDAR MLODYCH. "IS IT NOT A SALIENT FACT THAT BONN HAILED RUMANIA'S STAND AND DECLARED THAT IT IS CONVERGENT WITH THE STAND OF THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC ?

"ALSO, RUMANIA'S ATTITUDE TOWARDS THE NON-PROLIFERATION TREATY IS SIMILAR TO THAT ADOPTED BY WEST GERMAN REVANCHISTS. RUMANIA DEMANDED, THE SAME AS THE BONN GOVERNMENT DID, BIG POWERS GUARANTEES FOR NON-NUCLEAR STATES.

"THUS, IN A FINAL ACCOUNT, RUMANIA'S STAND IN THIS ISSUE, CONTRARY TO THE UNITED STAND OF SOCIALIST COUNTRIES, HAS DONE HARM TO THE CAUSE OF PARAMOUNT IMPORTANCE; IT IMPEDED AND DELAYED THE CONCLUSION OF THE NON-PROLIFERATION TREATY."
