X/4/9 C/S -- SOVIET, POLISH PAPERS ATTACK RUMANIA, YUGOSLAVIA

(RELEADS CN 38 AND CN 46 SERIES)

MUNICH, SEPT 6 (CMD) -- YUGOSLAVIA AND CHINA WERE SHARPLY ATTACKED IN THE SOVIET AND POLISH PRESS TODAY, AND RUMANIA WAS CRITICIZED BY TWO POLISH NEWSPAPERS.

IN MOSCOW, THE OFFICIAL MILITARY NEWSPAPER RED STAR CHARGED THAT THE CHINESE "SPLITTERS" AND YUGOSLAV "REVISIONISTS" HAVE BEEN HELPING THE WEST IN THE CURRENT CZECHOSLOVAK CRISIS.

RED STAR SAID THE WESTERN PRESS IS NOW MAKING SPECIAL EFFORTS TO "DEFAME" THE SOVIET UNION IN CONNECTION WITH THE EVENTS IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

"THESE EFFORTS," SAID RED STAR, "ARE FACILITATED BY THE ACTIONS OF THE CHINESE SPLITTERS, HEADED BY MAO TSE-TUNG, AND OF THE YUGOSLAV REVISIONISTS WHOSE ANTI-SOVIET THEMES ARE TAKEN UP BY IMPERIALIST PROPAGANDA."

IN WARSAW, THE POLISH MILITARY NEWSPAPER ZOLNIERZ WOLNOSCI ATTACKED YUGOSLAVIA AND RUMANIA BECAUSE THEY HAVE BEEN CRITICAL OF THE INVASION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

THE OFFICIAL POLISH YOUTH NEWSPAPER, SZTANDAR MLODYCH, ALSO DENOUNCED RUMANIA, NOT RPT NOT ONLY FOR ITS OPPOSITION TO THE INVASION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA, BUT ALSO FOR RUMANIA'S ATTITUDE TOWARD ISRAEL AND WEST GERMANY.

ZOLNIERZ WOLNOSCI ALSO CRITICIZED CHINA. IT SAID CHINESE POLICIES HAD CAUSED THE UNITED STATES TO ATTACK NORTH VIETNAM.
