X/4 C/S -- FOREIGN TROOPS ASK FOR STRAW, BOARDS , WATER

MUNICH, SEP 6 (CMD)-- RADIO BANSKA BYSTRICA SAID TODAY THAT A UNIT OF THE BULGARIAN ARMY HAD MOVED FROM THE IMMEDIATE VICINITY OF BANSKA BYSTRICA TO A NEW PLACE AT HORNY PRSANY.

THE CENTRAL SLOVAK RADIO ALSO SAID THAT THE TROOPS OF THE FIVE WARSAW PACT ARMIES CONTINUE TO STAY IN SEVERAL DISTRICTS OF THE REGION, MAINLY OUTSIDE OF LOCALITIE.

IN BANSKA BYSTRIVCA ITSELF, HOWEVER, FOREIGN TROOPS ARE STILL GUARDING THE EDITORIAL OFFICE OF THE ORGAN OF THE DISTRICT COMMITTEE OF THE SLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY, SMER, AS WELL AS THE PRINTING WORKS, AND MILITARY BARRACKS.

"LIKE IN ZILINA AND VELKY KRTIS DISTRICTS, FOREIGN OFFICERS IN HORNE POVAZIE ARE INTERESTED IN OUR INNER-PARTY PROBLEMS, IN THE RESULTS OF PARTY MEETINGS AND AKTIVS," THE RADIO ADDED.

RADIO BANSKA BYSTRICA THEN SAID: "IN SOME COOPERATIVE FARMS THEY ASK FOR STRAW, BOARDS, AND DRINKING WATER. AS COMPENSATION THEY OFFER AID TO BRIGADES IN THE FIELD WORK."
