X-13/ CS -- HELP TO CZECHOSLOVAKS IN WEST COORDINATED

PARIS SEPT. 6 (RFE SPECIAL/OVADIA) --- THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT HAS CREATED A "EUROPEAN ACTION COMMITTEE FOR THE AID TO CZECHOSLOVAKS", WHICH IS TO COORDINATE THE WORK OF VARIOUS GROUPS HELPING CZECHOSLOVAKS UNWILLING TO RETURN TO THEIR COUNTRY AT THIS TIME.

THE "EUROPEAN ACTION COMMITTEE" WAS ANNOUNCED IN PARIS LAST NIGHT BY ALAIN POHER, FRANCE, PRESIDENT OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT. OTHER COMMITTEE MEMBERS ARE J. ILLERHAUS, WEST GERMANY, PRESIDENT OF THE CHRISTIAN DEMOCRATS IN THE SIX-NATION ASSEMBLY, FRANCIS VALS, FRANCE, PRESIDENT OF THE SOCIALISTS,, FORMER FRENCH PREMIER RENE PLEVEN, PRESIDENT OF THE LIBERAL GROUP AND RAYMOND TRIBOULET, A FORMER MEMBER OF PRESIDENT CHARLES DE GAULLES GOVERNMENT, NOW HEAD OF THE EUROPEAN DEMOCRATIC UNION.

ALAIN POHER ALSO ANNOUNCED THAT THE BUREAU OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT, DUE TO MEET IN VENICE ON SEPTEMBER 11, WILL DISCUSS THE CZECHOSLOVAK SITUATION.
