"THE THREAT OF NUCLEAR WAR, HE CONTINUED, NECESSITATES THE ESTABLISHING OF ""RELATIONS OF PEACE AND COOPERATION BETWEEN STATES, WITHOUT DISTINCTION BETWEEN SOCIAL SYSTEMS, AND DEMANDS ORGANIZING IN A SOLID AND DURABLE MANNER PEACE IN THE WORLD."

"AWARE OF THE GREAT ADVANTAGES OF PEACE, AS WELL AS OF THE IMMENSITY OF THE DANGERS IMPLICIT IN WAR, RUMANIA PLACES ITSELF RESOLUTELY IN FAVOR OF BUILDING OF PEACE ON THE FOUNDATIONS OF RELATIONS BETWEEN STATES AND PEOPLE ON PRINCIPLES ACCEPTED BY THE ENTIRE WORLD: THE PRINCIPLES OF INDEPENDENCE, OF SOVEREIGNITY, EQUALITY OF RIGHTS, AND NON-INTERFERENCE IN INTERNAL AFFAIRS, OF RECIPROCAL RESPECT AND MUTUAL ADVANTAGE," HE SAID

"IT IS ONLY THROUGH THE RESPECT OF THESE PRINCIPLES , MAKING UP THE FUNDAMENTAL NORMS OF INTERNATIONAL RIGHTS, WHICH CAN ASSURE THE SPIRIT OF EQUALITY AND OF JUSTICE IN THE RELATIONS BETWEEN STATES," HE SAID, "" WHICH CAN ASSURE THE INALIENABLE RIGHTS OF EACH PEOPLE TO DECIDE BY THEMSELVES THEIR OWN AFFAIRS. THE PROMOTION OF THESE RIGHTS, THEIR DURABLE IMPLANTATION IN INTERNATIONAL LIFE IS AN IMPERATIVE OF DECISIVE IMPORTANCE FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF RELATIONS OF CONFIDENCE BETWEEN STATES..."

HE SAID THAT RUMANIA WAS IN FAVOR OF A CONVENTION CALLING FOR ""THE EXCLUSION OF FORCE AND OF THREATS TO DEPLOY FORCE AS A MEANS OF SETTLING INTERNATIONAL DIFFERENCES, AND BELIEVES THAT THE FIGHT AGAINST WAR AND THE RULE OF FORCE IS A PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITY OF ALL STATES."
