

U S - JOHNSON SAYS NO IMMEDIATE PROSPECT OF SUMMIT

"WE HAVE NO IMMEDIATE PLANS FOR SUMMIT MEETINGS--I SEE NONE IN THE OFFING AT THE MOMENT," HE TOLD A PRESS CONFERENCE.

THE PRESIDENT, WHO WARNED AGAINST ANY ACTION SIMILAR TO THE CZECHOSLOVAK INVASION IN A SPEECH IN SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS, LAST FRIDAY WAS ASKED IF HE FELT REASSURED ABOUT DEVELOPMENTS IN THE COMMUNIST BLOC SINCE THEN.

"WE HAVE HAD SOME ASSURANCES FOLLOWING THE SPEECH IN SAN ANTONIO, WHICH WE ARE VERY GLAD TO HAVE," HE SAID, "BUT WE CONTINUE TO MAINTAIN A DEEP INTEREST IN THAT PART OF THE WORLD."
