X/4 CS - SLOVAK DIRECTOR OF PRESS OFFICE APPOINTED

(RELEADS CN-71)

MUNICH, SEPT 6 (CMD)- THE SLOVAK NATIONAL COUNCIL HAS APPOINTED ONDREJ CEMAN DIRECTOR OF THE SLOVAK OFFICE FOR PRESS, RADIO AND TELEVISION, ACCORDING TO RADIO BRATISLAVA.

(CMD - THE SLOVAK OFFICE WAS ESTABLISHED AS OF SEPTEMBER FOUR. THE CZECHOSLOVAK GOVERNMENT SET UP AN OFFICE TO CONTROL THE MASS COMMUNICATION MEDIA LAST FRIDAY.)

THE APPOINTMENT OF THE SLOVAK OFFICE DIRECTOR WAS ANNOUNCED AT THE END OF A SESSION OF THE SLOVAK NATIONAL COUNCIL IN BRATISLAVA TODAY.

DURING THE SESSION, RADIO BRATISLAVA REPORTED, THE SLOVAK NATIONAL COUNCIL INCREASED THE NUMBER OF ITS MEMBERS BY ELECTING TO THE BODY 50 MORE REPRESENTATIVES OF SLOVAK PUBLIC LIFE.

THE COUNCIL THEN DISCUSSED A DRAFT LAW ON THE FEDERALIZATION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA. RADIO BRATISLAVA SAID THE DRAFT OUTLINES GENERAL QUESTIONS SUCH AS TERRITORIAL BORDERS, CITIZENSHIP AND CZECHOSLOVAK ECONOMY.

ONE PART OF THE LAW PROPOSES THE DIVISION OF COMPETENCES BETWEEN THE FEDERATION AND THE NATIONAL STATES, PRINCIPLES AND PLANNING OF THE ECONOMY IN A FEDERAL CZECHOSLOVAKIA, FINANCIAL SYSTEMS, TAXES, PRICES, FOREIGN TRADE AND OTHER SUBJECTS.
