X/4 CS - 1ST ADD ACCUSATIONS AGAINST SOVIET TRAFFIC DELAYS

(CN-144) XXX COUNTRIES

RADIO KOSICE SAID TONIGHT THAT AT THE SOVIET-CZECHOSLOVAK BORDER STATION OF CIERNA NAD TISOU SOVIET RAILWAYMEN "ARE NOT RPT NOT TAKING OVER OUR LOADED CARS.

"OUR ENTERPRISES ARE VAINLY DISPATCHING ORDERS AND DOING THE LOADING ON TIME. GOODS SLATED FOR THE SOVIET UNION ARE STANDING NOT RPT NOT ONLY AT CIERNA, BUT IN RAILWAY STATIONS NEAR CIERNA AS WELL," THE RADIO SAID.

YESTERDAY THERE WERE 60 CARS AND THIS MORNING ALREADY 210 CARS WERE INVOLVED.

"IF SOVIET RAILWAYMEN TODAY AGAIN FAIL TO BEGIN TAKING OVER OUR TRAINS, HUNDREDS OF LOADED CARS WILL BE STANDING AS FAR AS KOSICE AND THIS MEANS A SHORTAGE OF EMPTY CARS FOR FURTHER LOADING AS WELL," THE RADIO SAID.

LAST NIGHT (1755) RADIO KOSICE SAID CZECHOSLOVAK GOVERNMENT BODIES WERE RECEIVING SOVIET COMPLAINTS ABOUT THE WORK OF EASTERN SLOVAK RELOADING WORK, CHARGING THAT SLOVAK RAILWAYMEN ARE NOT RPT NOT ACCEPTING SOVIET CARS THUS CAUSING TRAFFIC DIFFICULTIES.

THE RADIO SAID THE KOSICE RAILWAY DEPARTMENT KNEW THE CHARGES WERE WRONG.

FOLLOWING TALKS IN CIERNA NAD TISOU LAST WEDNESDAY, RADIO KOSICE SAID YESTERDAY THE TRANSPORT SITUATION HAS NOT RPT NOT IMPROVED AND "THE SOVIET SIDE IS NOT RPT NOT ^NHAVING OVER THE AGREED NUMBER OF GOODS."
