

X/4 CS - MOSCOW WARNS RUMANIA AGAINST LOSING CONFIDENCE

MUNICH, SEPT 6 (CMD) - RADIO MOSCOW WARNED RUMANIANS IN A RUMANIAN LANGUAGE TRANSMISSION TONIGHT AGAINST LOSING CONFIDENCE IN RUMANIA'S "ALLIES".

THE RADIO'S COMMENTATOR KONSTANTIN IVANOV SAID, REFERRING TO EVENTS IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA:

"SOME FRIENDS OF OURS IN WESTERN EUROPE ASSUME THAT THE DECISION OF THE FIVE ALLIED SOCIALIST STATE TO GRANT ARMED AID TO CZECHOSLOVAK WORKERS WAS BASED ON WRONG INFORMATION.

"THIS HAS BEEN THE VIEW OF SOME RUMANIAN COMRADES, TOO.

"IT IS AN ABSOLUTELY WRONG VIEW. THE ACTIVITY OF ANTI-SOCIALIST FORCES, OVERTLY COUNTERREVOLUTIONARY, WHICH WAS CARRIED OUT IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA AFTER THE SOVIET-CZECHOSLOVAK (MOSCOW) ACCORD OF AUGUST 28, SHOWED THAT ALL INFORMATION WAS CORRECT.

"AT THE MAY PLENUM OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK PARTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE, AS WELL AS AT CIERNA AND BRATISLAVA, THE CZECHOSLOVAK LEADERS THEMSELVES RECOGNIZED THAT THE MAIN DANGER THREATENING THE REPUBLIC WAS COMING FROM THE RIGHTIST ANTISOCIALIST FORCES. NONE OF THE ALLIED SOCIALIST COUNTRIES HESITATED CONCERNING THE MEASURES ADOPTED IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

"IT IS EVIDENT THAT NOT ONLY THE INFORMATION MEDIA HAVE CEASED WORKING AS VOLUNTARY OR INVOLUNTARY DEFENDERS OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK RIGHTWING FIGHTERS. THEY HAVE LOST CONFIDENCE IN THE FIVE ALLIED SOCIALIST COUNTRIES, AND THIS IS REGRETTABLE.

"CONFIDENCE IS OF GREAT IMPORTANCE IN POLITICS AND NOT ONLY IN RELATIONS AMONG COUNTRIES WITH DIFFERENT SOCIAL SYSTEMS, BUT ALL THE MORE AMONG LEADERS OF SOCIALIST COUNTRIES AND COMMUNIST PARTIES."
