AUSTRIAN PRESIDENT TO VISIT YUGOSLAVIA
MUNICH, SEPT 6 (CMD)- AUSTRIAN PRESIDENT FRANZ JONAS AND HIS WIFE WILL PAY AN OFFICIAL VISIT TO YUGOSLAVIA BETWEEN SEPT 30 AND OCTOBER 5, RADIO BELGRADE REPORTS.

THE RADIO SAID THAT JONAS WILL RETURN PRESIDENT TITO'S VISIT TO AUSTRIA LAST YEAR.

VIENNA, SEPT 6 (RFE SPECIAL/KOSTRBA) -- FILMS MADE IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA BY AUSTRIAN TELEVISION DURING AND AFTER THE MILITARY INTERVENTION OF THE WARSAW PACT COUNTRIES, WILL BE GIVEN AT THE DISPOSAL OF POPE PAUL VI, AT HIS REQUEST FOR HIS PERSONAL INFORMATION, THE AUSTRIAN BROADCASTING CORPORATION ANNOUNCED FRIDAY NIGHT.

CONDUCTOR KARL RANKL DIES

SALZBURG, AUSTRIA, SEPT 6, REUTER - AUSTRIAN CONDUCTOR KARL RANKL, ONE OF THE PIONEERS OF CONTEMPORARY MUSIC AND FORMER DIRECTOR OF LONDONS COVENT GARDEN OPERA HOUSE, DIED IN HOSPITAL HERE LAST NIGHT, IT WAS ANNOUNCED HERE TODAY. HE WAS 70.

HOSPITAL OFFICIALS SAID HE DIED AFTER A LONG ILLNESS BUT GAVE NO FURTHER DETAILS.

RANKL WAS APPOINTED DIRECTOR OF COVENT GARDEN IN 1946.

HE LATER BECAME CHIEF CONDUCTOR OF THE SCOTTISH NATIONAL ORCHESTRA BEFORE ACCEPTING AN AUSTRALIAN POST AS DIRECTOR OF THE SYDNEY OPERA.
