

E/W - ITALIAN CP SENDS ENVOYS TO EAST EUROPE (RELEADS CN 160, 3RD ITEM)

ROME, SEPT 6, REUTER - THE ITALIAN COMMUNIST PARTY - THE BIGGEST IN THE WEST - TODAY SENT TWO SENIOR ENVOYS ON TRIPS TO EASTERN EUROPE.

THE FIRST TWO COUNTRIES THEY ARE VISITING ARE RUMANIA AND YUGOSLAVIA, WHICH HAVE JOINED THE ITALIAN PARTY IN CONDEMNING THE INVASION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

AFTER TALKS IN BUCHAREST WITH RUMANIAN PARTY LEADERS, SIGNOR GIANCARLO PAJETTA, A MEMBER OF THE ITALIAN PARTY POLITBURO, IS DUE TO GO ON TO BUDAPEST.

SIGNOR CARLO GALUZZI, THE PARTYS CHIEF FOREIGN AFFAIRS SPOKESMAN, IS DUE TO VISIT BULGARIA AFTER SEEING YUGOSLAV LEADERS IN BELGRADE, WHERE HE ARRIVED TONIGHT.

AN OFFICIAL ANNOUNCEMENT HERE SAID "INTENSE CONTACTS" WERE GOING ON BETWEEN THE ITALIAN COMMUNIST PARTY AND THE LEADERS OF COMMUNIST AND WORKERS PARTIES IN OTHER EUROPEAN COUNTRIES.

IT SAID SIGNOR PAJETTA HAD RECENTLY BEEN IN PARIS AND LONDON FOR TALKS WITH FRENCH AND BRITISH PARTY LEADERS AND WITH REPRESENTATIVES OF THE WORKERS PARTY OF NORTH VIETNAM.

YESTERDAY, ITALIAN PARTY LEADER LUIGI LONGO WAS REPORTED AS SAYING IN AN INTERVIEW THAT THE WORLD COMMUNIST CONFERENCE PLANNED FOR MOSCOW THIS AUTUMN MUST BE POSTPONED UNTIL THE CZECHOSLOVAK SITUATION IS NORMALIZED.
