

"LOSING CONFIDENCE," THE COMMENTATOR ADDED, "CAN CAUSE SERIOUS PREJUDICES TO THEIR COMMON INTERESTS. THIS WAS SHOWN ALSO BY THE FRUSTRATION OF THE AGREEMENT REACHED AS A RESULT OF THE CIERNA NAD TISSOU AND BRATISLAVA MEETINGS...."

THE MOSCOW COMMENTATOR THEN CONDEMNED WHAT HE CALLED THE "INCONSISTENT AFFIRMATIONS" OF THE YUGOSLAV LEADERS, PRESS AND RADIO WHICH, HE SAID, "...AFFIRMED VEHEMENTLY THAT THE USSR AND THE ALLIED SOCIALIST COUNTRIES DID NOT RPT NOT NOT SUFFICIENTLY TAKE INTO ACCOUNT CZECHOSLOVAKIA'S PECULIARITIES, HER HISTORICAL PAST NOR THE VIEW OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK FRIENDS ON SPECIFIC PROBLEMS OF SOCIALIST CONSTRUCTION IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA...."

HE ADDED: "IN THE SOCIAL AND POLITICAL SYSTEM OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA, IMPORTANT PARTICULARITIES EXISTED WHICH RESULTED FROM THE CONCRETE WAYS OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA'S DEVELOPMENT: THERE EXISTED AND STILL EXISTS THE SYSTEM OF VARIOUS PARTIES WHICH DOES NOT RPT NOT EXIST IN THE USSR...WHILE TILL RECENTLY MISSING IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA WAS THE FEDERAL PRINCIPLE OF SOLVING NATIONAL PROBLEMS ALTHOUGH THE SOVIET PARTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE, AS FAR BACK AS IN 1945 ADVISED THE CZECHOSLOVAK LEADERS TO TAKE INTO ACCOUNT THE SOVIET EXPERIENCE IN SOLVING NATIONAL PROBLEMS....."

"THERE EXIST IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA SPECIFIC FORMS OF SOCIALIST ADMINISTRATION IN VILLAGES, SPECIAL TIES BETWEEN STATE AND CHURCH. MISSING IN THE HISTORY OF THE SOCIALIST REPUBLIC OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA HAVE BEEN ALSO SUCH PHENOMENA AS THE DEPRIVATION OF POLITICAL RIGHTS FOR PEOPLE BELONGING TO THE EXPLOITING CLASSES, THE LIQUIDATION OF KULAKS AS A CLASS AND OTHERS. ALL THIS SHOWS THAT THE USSR AND ITS COMMUNIST PARTY NEVER TRIED TO IMPOSE ON CZECHOSLOVAKIA AND HER PEOPLE THEIR METHODS FOR SOLVING THE PROBLEMS OF SOCIALIST CONSTRUCTION...."

"THE TROOPS OF THE ALLIED COUNTRIES WHICH ARE ON CZECHOSLOVAK TERRITORY TEMPORARILY, WILL NOT RPT NOT INTERFERE WITH THE DOMESTIC AFFAIR OF THE REPUBLIC...."

THE COMMENTATOR RECALLED THAT THE 1957 CONFERENCE OF THE "FRATERNAL COMMUNIST PARTIES" ADOPTED A RESOLUTION SAYING IN PART: THE SOCIALIST COUNTRIES ORGANIZE THEIR RELATIONS ON THE PRINCIPLES OF FULL EUQUALITY IN RIGHTS, RESPECT FOR TERRITORIAL INTEGRITY, STATE INDEPENDENCE AND SOVEREIGNTY, NON-INTERFERENCE.....

"THESE," HE CONCLUDED, "ARE IMPORTANT PRINCIPLES BUT NOT RPT NOT COMPRISING THE ENTIRE ESSENCE OF RELATIONS AMONG SOCIALIST COUNTRIES. MUTUAL FRATERNAL AID IS AN INALIENABLE PART OF RELATIONS AMONG THEM....."
