

CS FOREIGN TRADE ORGANISATION RESUMING DELIVERIES TO FRG

FRANKFURT, SEPTEMBER 6 (VWD/GND) -- THE DELIVERIES OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK FOREIGN TRADE ORGANISATION MOKOTOV WILL BE RESUMED IMMEDIATELY, THE DEPUTY DIRECTOR GENERAL OF THE ORGANISATION, DR. KAREL ALMASY SAID IN FRANKFURT TODAY.

HE SAID THAT RAIL TRAFFIC AND PRODUCTION MEANTIME HAD BECOME "SUFFICIENTLY NORMAL."

THE MOKOTOV ORGANISATION PLANS TO SELL INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTS WORTH 24 MILLION MARKS DURING 1968 IN WEST GERMANY MAINLY CONSISTING OF SKODA CARS, TRACTORS, LORRIES, MOTOCYCLES AND BYCICLES, HE SAID.

DR. ALMASY VOICED THE OPINION THAT THE FUTURE DEVELOPMENT OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA'S TRADE WITH WEST GERMANY WOULD STILL BE "FAVORABLE."

THERE WOULD BE NO RESTRICTIONS CONCERNING CZECHOSLOVAKIA'S TRADE WITH WESTERN COUNTRIES, HE ADDED.

AIR TRAFFIC PRAGUE-BUDAPEST TO RESUME

VIENNA, SEPTEMBER 6 (DPA/GND) - THE HUNGARIAN AIR LINE MALEV WILL REOPEN ITS REGULAR FLIGHTS TO PRAGUE NEXT MONDAY, THE HUNGARIAN NEWS AGENCY MTI SAID TODAY.

THE AIRFIELD OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK CAPITAL WAS CLOSED FOR ALL CIVILIAN TRAFFIC SINCE THE BEGINNING OF THE OCCUPATION.

STUDENTS TO STAY IN FRANCE

PARIS, SEPT 6, REUTER -- MANY THE 500 OR SO CZECHOSLOVAK UNIVERSITY STUDENTS STRANDED HERE BY THE SOVIET OCCUPATION OF THEIR COUNTRY HAVE CHOSEN TO STAY IN FRANCE, ONE OF THEIR LEADERS, MICHAL CERMAK, SAID TODAY.

THE FRENCH GOVERNMENT IS TO CONTRIBUTE 480,000 FRANCS (ABOUT 40,000 STERLING) AS A RELIEF FUND TO HELP THE STUDENTS AND HAS GRANTED THEM RESIDENCE PERMITS AND GIVEN THEM A 400-FRANC (ABOUT 33 STERLING) MONTHLY ALLOWANCE.

FRENCH SENATOR ALAIN POHER, CHAIRMAN OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND HEAD OF ITS NEWLY-FORMED ACTION COMMITTEE TO HELP THE CZECHOSLOVAK PEOPLE, SAID HE WOULD SOON GET IN TOUCH WITH THE PARLIAMENTS OF THE SIX COMMON MARKET COUNTRIES AND BRITAIN TO CO-ORDINATE AID AT EUROPEAN LEVEL.
