X/4 CS - HAMOUZ INSTRUCTS LOCAL OFFICIALS

MUNICH, SEPT 7 (CMD)- CZECHOSLOVAK DEPUTY PREMIER FRANTISEK HAMOUZ HAS CALLED ON OFFICIALS OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK REGIONAL AND DISTRICT NATIONAL COMMITTEES (LOCAL GOVERNMENT) TO HOLD TALKS WITH THE COMMANDERS OF FOREIGN TROOPS IN THE COUNTRY, RADIO PRAGUE REPORTED FRIDAYNIGHT.

THE RADIO SAID THAT HAMOUZ MET IN PRAGUE FRIDAY WITH REPRESENTATIVES OF NATIONAL COMMITTEES AND WORKERS OF INDIVIDUAL MINISTERIES AND TOLD THEM THAT THE CZECHOSLOVAK GOVERNMENT IS DOING ITS UTMOST TO IMPLEMENT THE MOSCOW AGREEMENTS.

HE SAID THAT IN THE ECONOMIC FIELD IT IS NECESSARY TO RESTORE THE RHYTHM OF PRODUCTION AND OF ECONOMIC LIFE. HE SAID THE GOVERNMENT DOES NOT WANT TO GO ALONG THE ROAD OF "DIRECTIVE ORDER", BUT RATHER ALONG THE ROAD OF ECONOMIC MEASURES.

THE RADIO SAID THAT HAMOUZ "APPEALED TO ALL FUNCTIONARIES OF THE REGIONAL AND DISTRICT NATIONAL COMMITTEES THAT THEY SHOULD NEGOTIATE WITH THE COMMANDERS OF FOREIGN ARMIES," AND TRY TO SOLVE AS MANY PROBLEMS AS POSSIBLE IN THEIR AREAS OF ACTION SUCH AS PROBLEMS CONNECTED WITH PRODUCTION, TRANSPORTATION, AND HEALTH SERVICES.

HE SAID THAT OFFICIALS WOULD HAVE ONLY TO TURN TO THE GOVERNMENT IN CASES WHICH THEY CANNOT SOLVE BY THEIR OWN MEANS.
