WORLD -- C/S OCCUPATION DENOUNCED AT LIMA CONGRESS

LIMA, PERU, SEPT 7 (UPI)-STRONG CRITICISMS OF THE WARSAW PACT INVASION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA OCCUPIED THE AGENDA OF THE 16TH WORLD INTERPARLIAMENTARY CONGRESS FRIDAY.

SINCE THE CONGRESS, WHICH IS MEETING DELEGATIONS FROM 66 NATIONS, OPENED THURSDAY, 15 COUNTRIES HAVE TAKEN THE PODIUM TO DENOUNCE THE SOVIET-LED INVASION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

CENSURING THE ACTION SO FAR HAVE BEEN CANADA, IRELAND, CAMEROON, IRAN, SWITZERLAND, WEST GERMANY, THE NETHERLANDS, FRANCE, INDIA, FINLAND, ETHIOPIA, ITALY, VENEZUELA, THE PHILIPPINES AND GREAT BRITAIN.

THE MOST ENERGETIC DENUNCIATION CAME FROM THE FRENCH DELEGATION WHICH CALLED THE RUSSIANS "ASSASSINS" AND DEMANDED THAT THEY BE EJECTED FROM THE CONFERENCE.

THE THEME OF NON-INTERVENTION WAS CHOSEN AT LAST YEAR'S MEETING IN DAKAR TO BE THE CMITF TOPIC AT THIS YEAR'S CONGRESS.

THE ONLY DELEGATIONS THAT HAVE SO FAR COME OUT TO SUPPORT THE SOVIET ACTION HAVE BEEN FROM POLAND AND MONGOLIA.
