X/4 C/S - RAILROAD TRAFFIC NORMALIZING

MUNICH, SEPT 7, (REUTER)/CMD - BRATISLAVA RADIO SAID TODAY THAT RAILWAY GOODS TRAFFIC IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA WAS NEARLY BACK TO NORMAL BUT SOME EXPRESS TRAINS WERE BEING DELAYED BY TRACK REPAIRS.

CZECHOSLOVAK AIRLINES WOULD REOPEN SOME INTERNATIONAL FLIGHTS NEXT MONDAY, BARGE TRAFFIC ON THE DANUBE WAS BACK TO NORMAL BUT COACH AND RIVER PASSENGER TRAFFIC TO HUNGARY HAD NOT YET STARTED AGAIN.

THE POSTAL SERVICES WERE BACK IN OPERATION AND LONG-DISTANCE TELEPHONE CALLS COULD BE MADE, THE RADIO SAID.

THE RADIO ADDED:

"BROADCASTING IS STILL MEETING WITH CERTAIN DIFFICULTIES, AND MEDIUM - WAVE TRANSMISSIONS ARE STILL NOT AUDIBLE IN PARTS OF SOUTHERN BOHEMIA, SOUTHERN AND EASTERN MORAVIA, AND CENTRAL SLOVAKIA.
