X/4 C/S -- SLOVAK OFFICIAL AGAINST "LIFE-TIME OFFICIALS"

MUNICH, SEPT 7 (CMD) -- THE CHAIRMAN OF THE SLOVAK NATIONAL FRONT, SAMUEL FALTAN, TODAY OPPOSED WHAT HE TERMED LIFE-TIME OFFICIALS.

ACCORDING TO RADIO BRATISLAVA, FALTAN WROTE IN TODAY'S SLOVAK PARTY DAILY PRAVDA THAT IN THE FUTURE "MORALE MUST EXIST ALSO IN THIS SPHERE; OFFICIALS SHOULD BE ACTIVE THROUGHOUT A CERTAIN PERIOD WHICH SHOULD BE ENDED, FOR EXAMPLE, BY A CONGRESS."

"IT IS REALLY INCORRECT THAT SOMEONE BE A PROFESSIONAL FUNCTIONARY FOR YEARS.... THE PARTY IS STRONG ENOUGH TODAY AND IT IS CAPABLE OF EDUCATING FURTHER FUNCTIONARIES," FALTAN SAID.

"THIS DOES NOT RPT NOT MEAN THAT THEY CAN NOT RPT NOT RETURN AFTER SOME TIME," HE ADDED.

FALTAN ALSO SAID NEW OFFICIALS WERE NOW ENCOUNTERING "UNEXPECTEDLY DIFFICULT CONDITIONS AND IT WILL BE THEIR MISSION TO STAND FIRM, TO PRESERVE THE AUTHORITY OF THE PARTY, THE HONOUR OF THE COMMUNISTS AS PATRIOTS AND AS MARXISTS-INTERNATIONALISTS IN THE SPIRIT OF THE POST JANUARY DEVELOPMENT..."
