

X/4 C/S -- YUGOSLAV YOUTH LEADER ATTACKS 'BUREAUCRATIC SOCIALISM'

BELGRADE, SEPT 7 (CMD) -- JANEZ KOCIJANCIC, PRESIDENT OF THE YUGOSLAV YOUTH ORGANIZATION, SAID TODAY THE OCCUPATION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA HAD SHOWN THAT "BUREAUCRATIC SOCIALISM" OFFERED NEITHER "HUMANE OR JUST SOLUTIONS" TO SOCIAL PROBLEMS.

ACCORDING TO TANJUG, KOCIJANCIC SAID THAT, ON THE CONTRARY, "BUREAUCRATIC SOCIALISM" WAS NOT RPT NOT IN THE INTEREST OF THE WORKING CLASS.

THE OCCUPATION OF ONE SOCIALIST COUNTRY BY FIVE OTHERS ILLUSTRATES A POLICY WHICH HAS RETAINED ONLY A "DEMAGOGIC PHRASE" FROM MARXISM, HE SAID.
