

YESTERDAY

(UPI) - IN MOSCOW PRAVDA TODAY SAID THE AUSTRIAN, WEST GERMAN AND YUGOSLAV PRESS "WERE TRYING TO FOOL CZECHOSLOVAK TOURISTS ABROAD BY SPREADING ALL SORTS OF WILD STORIES" AND SUGGESTING SOVIET TROOPS BEHAVED AS "TRUE THIEVES."

THE SOVIET PARTY PAPER SAID HUNDREDS OF CZECHOSLOVAKS WERE RETURNING EACH DAY AND "THEY CRIED AT THE BORDER WHEN THEY FOUND HOW TMEY WERE DECEIVED."

IN A DISPATCH FROM THE PETRZALKA CHECKPOINT ON THE CZECHOSLOVAK-AUSTRIAN BORDER, THE PAPER QUOTED CZECH MAJ. JOSEF MARTINEK AS SAYING THAT THERE WAS NO INTERRUPTION OF TRAFFIC IN BOTH DIRECTIONS "FOR A SINGLE DAY."

WHILE ENTRY INTO CZECHOSLOVAKIA IS TEMPORARILY RESTRICTED TO FOREIGN TOURISTS, PRAVDA SAID, CZECHOSLOVAK CITIZENS "HAVE THE POSSIBILITY FREELY TO LEAVE AND ENTER THEIR COUNTRY."

IT SAID CZECHOSLOVAKS IN AUSTRIA "WERE GIVEN A PLATE OF SOUP A DAY BY THEIR TENDER-HEARTED HOSTS (ALONG) WITH AN ULTIMATUM TO EITHER STAY IN AUSTRIA FOREVER OR GO BACK."

"THE CAPITALISTS WILL NEVER FEED ANYBODY FOR NOTHING," PRAVDA ADDED.

THE NEWSPAPER SOVYETSKAYA ROSSIYA (SOVIET RUSSIA), MEANWHILE, CHARGED THAT FORMER CZECHOSLOVAK MAJ. GEN. JAN SEJNA, WHO FLED TO THE UNITED STATES EARLIER THIS YEAR, IS CURRENTLY ACTING AS A TOP MILITARY ADVISER FOR THE U.S. CENTRAL INTELLIGENCE AGENCY.

THE PAPER SAID CIA AGENTS, IN COOPERATION WITH WEST GERMANY'S INTELLIGENCE, FORMED THE "NUCLEUS" OF CLANDESTINE "SPY NETWORK" INSIDE CZECHOSLOVAKIA AIMED AT RENDERING ACTIVE HELP TO COUNTER-REVOLUTIONARIES.
