X/4 CS - 300 CZECHOSLOVAKS IN VARNA TO BE AIRLIFTED HOME

MUNICH, SEPT 7 (CMD)- A CZECHOSLOVAK I.L. 14 AIRCRAFT TODAY FLEW TO THE BULGARIAN BLACK SEA PORT OF VARNA TO PICK UP MORE THAN 300 HOLIDAYMAKERS STRANDED THERE BY THE CZECHOSLOVAK CRISIS.

RADIO PRAGUE SAID IT WAS THE FIRST CZECHOSLOVAK AIRLINES PLANE TO ARRIVE IN BULGARIA FOR 18 DAYS. THE AIRCRAFT STOPPED IN THE BULGARIAN CAPITAL OF SOFIA BEFORE FLYING ON TO VARNA.

THE RADIO SAID THAT APART FROM THE 300 TO BE AIRLIFTED HOME SEVERAL SMALLER GROUPS OF CZECHOSLOVAK HOLIDAYMAKERS IN BULGARIA WOULD RETURN HOME BY TRAIN.
