THE OCCUPATION OF ONE SOCIALIST COUNTRY BY ANOTHER ILLUSTRATES A POLICY WHICH HAS RETAINED ONLY A "DEMOGOGIC PHRASE" FROM MARXISM, KOCIJANCIC SAID.

IN VIENNA, THE AUSTRIAN PARTY NEWSPAPER VOLKSSTIMME SAID THAT NORMALIZATION IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA MUST INCLUDE THE WITHDRAWAL OF TROOPS AND THE RE-ESTABLISHMENT OF THE COUNTRY'S INDEPENDENCE.

VOLKSSTIMME, QUOTING PRAVDA AND IZVESTIA ARTICLES, SAID THE SOVIET NEWSPAPERS' VIEWS INDICATED NO WILLINGNESS BY THE SOVIETS TO WITHDRAW THEIR TROOPS.

IN ROME, A LEADING COMMUNIST, GIORGIO AMENDOLA, SAID THAT ANY ATTEMPT BY ONE PARTY TO IMPOSE ON THE OTHERS ITS INTERPRETATION OF MARXISM-LENINISM COULD ONLY AGGRAVATE THE POSITION OF WORLD COMMUNISM "ALREADY SO DIVIDED BY DIVERGENCIES."

THE LATEST ISSUE OF THE ITALIAN COMMUNIST WEEKLY RINASCITA CARRIES A FRONT-PAGE EDITORIAL BY AMENDOLA WHICH DEFENDED THE ITALIAN PARTY'S CONDEMNATION OF THE WARSAW PACT OCCUPATION.
