

X/4 C/S - C/S TELEVISION ANNOUNCER REJECTS EAST GERMAN CRITICISM

MUNICH, SEPT 7 (CMD)- A CZECHOSLOVAK TELEVISION WOMAN ANNOUNCER TONIGHT REJECTED ACCUSATIONS BY YESTERDAY'S ISSUE OF THE EAST GERMAN PARTY DAILY NEUES DEUTSCHLAND SAYING THAT SHE "READ INCITING AND HATEFUL REPORTS ON ILLEGAL TELEVISION" IN THE DAYS AFTER AUGUST 21.

THE TELEVISION ANNOUNCER SAID: "THE PAPER NEUES DEUTSCHLAND YESTERDAY INFORMED ITS READERS THAT CZECHOSLOVAK TELEVISION HAD RESUMED ITS TELECASTS ON WEDNESDAY."

"THIS DAILY," SHE WENT ON, "EXPRESSES ASTONISHMENT OVER THE FACT THAT IT WAS ME WHO READ THE INTRODUCTORY WORD, EXPLAINING THAT OUR TELEVISION WANTS TO CONTINUE IN THE ROAD EMBARKED IN JANUARY, AND IT CRITICIZES ME THAT I READ, IN THE STIRRED DAYS AFTER AUGUST 21, INCITING AND HATEFUL REPORTS ON ILLEGAL TELEVISION."

THE ANNOUNCER SAID "ON BEHALF OF MYSELF AND OF MY COLLEAGUES, I WOULD LIKE TO SAY THE FOLLOWING TO THIS:

"WE ARE ANNOUNCERS OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK TELEVISION, WHICH WAS, AND CONTINUES TO BE A COMMUNICATION MEDIUM OF THE LEGAL CZECHOSLOVAK GOVERNMENT."

"THE INTRODUCTORY EDITORIAL STATEMENT, WHICH I READ ON WEDNESDAY, AND IN WHICH THE ENTIRE CZECHOSLOVAK TELEVISION EXPRESSED ITS SUPPORT OF THE LEADERSHIP OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY, AND ALSO OF THE RECTIFICATION OF DEFORMATION OF SOCIALISM AS WE STARTED IT IN JANUARY, IS NOT RPT NOT AT ALL AT VARIANCE WITH THE AGREEMENTS SIGNED IN MOSCOW."
