CS - ROCKEFELLER CALLS FOR NATO REVIEW

NEW YORK, SEPT 8 (UPI)--GOVERNOR NELSON ROCKEFELLER OF NEW YORK CALLED SATURDAY FOR "AN IMMEDIATE HIGH-LEVEL REVIEW" OF NATO POLICIES IN THE FACE OF THE SOVIET UNION'S INVASION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

CALLING THE INVASION "AN OUTRAGE AGAINST ALL THE PEOPLES OF THE WORLD," THE TWICE-DEFEATED CANDIDATE FOR THE REPUBLICAN PRESIDENTIAL NOMINATION SAID RUSSIA'S ACTION DEMANDED "A MOST CAREFUL RE-EXAMINATION OF THE EAST-WEST RELATIONSHIP."

ROCKEFELLER SAID IN A STATEMENT THE NATO ALLIES SHOULD REVIEW THEIR RELATIONSHIPS "TO DEVELOP POLICIES, CONCEPTS AND INSITUTIONS NOT ONLY FOR THE IMMEDIATE SITUATION, BUT FOR SHAPING THE FUTURE."

HE ALSO URGED THE U.S. SENATE TO DEFER ACTION ON THE NUCLEAR NON-PROLIFERATION TREATY UNTIL JANUARY WHEN "IT WILL BE POSSIBLE TO ACCESS THE RAMIFICATIONS OF THE SOVIET ACTION FROM A BETTER PERSPECTIVE."
