EURO -- YUGOSLAVAS DISCUSS DEFENSE

SARAJEVON YUGOSLAVIA, SEPT 8 (UPI) -- REGIONAL OFFICIALS OF THE BOSNIA-HERCEGOVINA REPUBLIC SATURDAY DISCUSSED "COORDINATED TASKS FOR THE DEFENSE OF THE COUNTRY," TANJUG SAID.

BRANKO MIKULIC, PREMIER OF BOSNIA-HERCEGOVINA, PRESIDED OVER THE SESSION ATTENDED BY THE PRESIDENTS OF ALL CITY ASSEMBLIES, PARLIAMENTARY DEPUTIES AND REPRESENTATIVES OF THEIR POLITICAL ORGANIZATIONS OF THIS PROVINCE IN CENTRAL YUGOSLAVIA, WHICH HAS NO BORDERS WITH FOREIGN COUNTRIES.
