X/4 CS -- RADIO MOSCOW SAYS WESTERN TROOPS TO SOCIALIST BORDERS
"DANGEROUS"

MUNICH, SEPT 8 (CMD) -- RADIO MOSCOW LAST NIGHT DESCRIBED AS DANGEROUS AND UNWISE A WESTERN POLICY WHICH WOULD SEND TROOPS TO THE BORDERS OF THE SOCIALIST COUNTRIES.

IN A COMMENTARY BY GELIY SHAKHOV BROADCAST TO TURKEY, RADIO MOSCOW SAID SUCH A POLICY COULD ONLY LEAD TO TENSION IN THE INTERNATIONAL ATMOSPHERE.

THE COMMENTATOR ALSO SAID THAT "RECENT EVENTS HAD SHOWN THAT AFTER THE FAILURE OF A COUP D'ETAT IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA, THE WEST TOOK THE PATH OF INTERVENTION FROM OUTSIDE. THIS ONCE MORE SHOWS THAT THE DECISION TO RENDER MILITARY AID TO THE CZECHOSLOVAK PEOPLE, WHO WANTED TO DEFEND THEIR SOCIALIST GAINS AND FUTURE, WAS TAKEN JUST IN TIME."
