

X/4 C/S -- RADIO VLTAVA ATTACKS BY NAME SEVERAL LEADING C/S WRITERS  
AND JOURNALISTS

MUNICH, SEPT 8 (CMD) -- THE SOVIET CONTROLLED RADIO "VLTAVA" IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA TODAY ATTACKED BY NAME SEVERAL PROMINENT CZECHOSLOVAK JOURNALISTS AND WRITERS.

AMONG THOSE DESCRIBED BY RADIO "VLTAVA" AS "PIONEERS OF COUNTER-REVOLUTION, IDEOLOGICAL STRATEGISTS WHO WERE TO THROW DUST TO THE EYES OF THE PEOPLE, WHO CAUSED CHAOS, DISSATISFACTION, AND UNCERTAINTY," WERE:

EDITOR IN CHIEF OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK WRITERS' UNION'S WEEKLY LITERARNI LISTY, MILAN JUNGMAHN AND HIS DEPUTY LUDVIK VESELY, PROFESSOR IVAN SVITAK, (PHILOSOPHER AND LEADING OFFICIAL OF THE 'CLUB OF COMMITTED NON-PARTY PEOPLE'), WHOM RADIO VLTAVA DESCRIBED AS "THE MAIN THEORETICIAN OF COUNTER-REVOLUTION"; JIRINA PETRINOVA WHO, IN THE WORDS OF VLTAVA, "DID NOT RPT NOT KNOW LIMITS IN THE INCITING AGAINST THE SOVIET UNION AND THE OTHER SOCIALIST COUNTRIES"; PETR KETNER, THE FORMER EDITOR IN CHIEF OF THE STUDENTS WEEKLY 'STUDENT'; IGOR HAJEK; IVAN STEIGER; STANISLAV BUDIN "FROM (THE CZECHOSLOVAK JOURNALISTS' SEMI-MONTHLY) 'REPORTER'"; PROMINENT WRITER JOSEF SKVORECKY; PRESIDENT OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK WRITERS UNION EDUARD GOLDSTUECKER; AND PLAY-RIGHT PAVEL KOHOUT.

RADIO VLTAVA LISTED THESE PEOPLE AND ADDED THAT THERE ARE "NUMEROUS OTHERS" LIKE THEM. IT SAID "THEY WERE READY TO BETRAY HUMANISM AND SELL THEIR FATHERLAND FOR A CHEAP APPLAUSE OF MONOPOLISTS, AND FOR PAYMENT IN HARD CURRENCY."

"NOW GROUND WAS BURNING UNDER THEIR FEET, AND THEY LEFT THE COUNTRY, ALTHOUGH THEY PRETEND THAT THEY LOVE IT."
