X/4 C/S -- PROBLEMS IN REOPENING OF FOOTBALL COMPETITIONS

MUNICH, SEPT. 9 (CMD) - THE CHAIRMAN OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK SPORTS UNION DR. EMANUEL BOSAK SAID LAST NIGHT THERE WERE PROBLEMS IN REOPENING TOP FOOTBALL COMPETITION IN HIS COUNTRY BECAUSE IT MEANT "THE ASSEMBLING OF A GREAT NUMBER OF PEOPLE."

IN AN INTERVIEW WITH CZECHOSLOVAK TELEVISION, BOSAK SPOKE ABOUT EFFORTS TO NORMALIZE THE COUNTRY'S SPORTS ACTIVITIES.

REFERRING TO TOP SOCCER COMPETITIONS, HE SAID: "A CERTAIN PROBLEM REMAINS TO BE THE RE-OPENING OF THE CENTRAL COMPETITIONS IN SOCCER, BECAUSE INVOLVED HERE IS THE ASSEMBLING OF A GREAT NUMBER OF PEOPLE AND ALSO NOT RPT NOT ALL OF THESE FIRST LEAGUE PLAYGROUNDS ARE QUITE FREE."

BOSAK ADDED THAT HE HOPED THIS DIFFICULTY WOULD BE SUCCESSFULLY OVERCOME UNDER THE SUPPORT OF THE GOVERNMENT BODIES SO THAT "WE WOULD RESUME THE CENTRAL SOCCER COMPETITIONS IN THE COURSE OF THE NEXT WEEK."

BOSAK ALSO EXPRESSED IN HIS CONVICTION THAT CZECHOSLOVAKIA WOULD PARTICIPATE IN THE OLYMPIC GAMES IN MEXICO.

HE ADDED THE CZECHOSLOVAK OLYMPIONICS WOULD NOT RPT NOT HAVE AN EASY TASK THERE, BECAUSE "COMPETITION WILL BE IMMENSE.. AND THE PSYCHIC STATE OF MAY OF THOSE BOYS AND GIRLS HAS BEEN A LITTLE DISTURBED." (CZECHOSLOVAK TELEVISION/M SEPT 8 1900)
