WORLD -- THE DAY AHEAD

MUNICH, SEPT. 9 (CNR) -- THE AFTERMATH OF A MIDDLE EAST CLASH, THE SITUATION IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA AND THE ACTIVITIES OF WEST EUROPEAN LEADERS DOMINATE THE NEWS TODAY.

THE UNITED NATIONS SECURITY COUNCIL CONVENED EARLY MONDAY (MT) TO DISCUSS SUNDAY'S ARTILLERY DUEL ACROSS THE SUEZ CANAL BETWEEN ISRAEL AND THE UNITED ARAB REPUBLIC.

NORMALIZATION OF LIFE IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA IS EXPECTED TO CONTINUE TODAY. INTERNATIONAL AIRLINES WILL BE ALLOWED TO RESUME FLYING INTO AND OUT OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA TODAY, RADIO/CZECHOSLOVAKIA ANNOUNCED LAST NIGHT.

BRITISH FOREIGN SECRETARY MICHAEL STEWART OPENS HIS TALKS WITH RUMANIAN MINISTERS THIS MORNING BY CALLING ON FOREIGN MINISTER CORNELIU MANESCU AT 0930 MT.

FRENCH PRESIDENT CHARLES DE GAULLE HOLDS A PRESS CONFERENCE TODAY FOLLOWING HIS COUNTRY'S SECOND TEST OF A HYDROGEN BOMB.

WEST GERMAN CHANCELLOR KURT GEORG KIESINGER FLIES FROM ISTANBUL TO TEHERAN TODAY AS HE CONTINUES HIS VISIT TO TURKEY.

BELGIAN FOREIGN MINISTER PIERRE HARMEL ARRIVES IN BONN TODAY FOR TALKS WITH FOREIGN MINISTER WILLY BRANDT.

NORTH KOREA CELEBRATES ITS 20TH ANNIVERSARY TODAY.

THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF THE EUROPEAN FOOTBALL UNION HOLDS AN EXTRAORDINARY MEETING TODAY IN ZURICH TO DEAL WITH EAST EUROPEAN PROTESTS AGAINST THE CHANGES IN THE DRAW FOR EUROPEAN CUP COMPEITION RESULTING FROM THE INVASION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

ON THE LIGHTER SIDE TODAY, THE "ATHENEE" THEATER OF PARIS PRESENTS A NEW VERSION OF "TO EACH HIS TRUTH", BY LUIGI PIRANDELLO.

THE FOURTH WORLD CONGRESS OF ANAESTHESIOLOGISTS WILL OPEN AT THE ROYAL FESTIVAL HALL TODAY WITH SOME EAST EUROPEAN DELEGATES EXPECTED. BRITAIN IS THE HOST FOR THE FIRST TIMES AND THE CONGRESS CONTINUES UNTIL SEPT 13.
