X X X CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

GIVING AN EXAMPLE, RADIO MOSCOW SAID CZECHOSLOVAKIA STILL HAS A "MULTI-PARTY SYSTEM" ALTHOUGH THIS SYSTEM DOES NOT RPT NOT EXIST IN THE SOVIET UNION.

THE RADIO ALSO SAID THERE ARE "BIG CONSTITUTIONAL DIFFERENCES" BETWEEN THE SOVIET UNION AND CZECHOSLOVAKIA. UNTIL RECENTLY, IT SAID, THE FEDERAL PRINCIPLE CONCERNING NATIONALIST QUESTIONS WAS NOT RPT NOT BEING CONSIDERED IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA ALTHOUGH THE SOVIET CENTRAL COMMITTEE HAD ADVISED CZECHOSLOVAK OFFICIALS ALREADY IN 1945 TO "CONSIDER THE USSR'S EXPERIENCE IN THE SOLUTION OF NATIONALITY QUESTIONS..."

IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA, THE BROADCAST CONTINUED, THERE ARE SPECIFIC FORMS OF SOCIALIST ECONOMY IN THE COUNTRYSIDE AND SPECIAL RELATIONS BETWEEN THE STATE AND THE CHURCH.

IT ALSO SAID "THERE WERE NO RPT NO SUCH PHENOMENA IN THE HISTORY OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA AS THE TAKING AWAY OF POLITICAL RIGHTS FROM PERSONS BELONGING TO THE EXPLOITOR CLASSES, THE LIQUIDATION OF RICH VILLAGES AS A CLASS, ETC."

"ALL THIS," THE RADIO DECLARED, "PROVES THAT THE SOVIET UNION AND THE COMMUNIST PARTY OF THE USSR HAVE NEVER TRIED TO ENFORCE THEIR EXPERIENCE IN SOLVING THE TASKS OF BUILDING SOCIALISM ON CZECHOSLOVAKIA AND HER PEOPLE."
