

X/4 CS - BUCHAREST: KIM IL SONG CONDEMNS "OUTSIDE PRESSURE"

MUNICH, SEPT 9 (CMD) - RADIO BUCHAREST REPORTS THAT NORTH KOREAN PARTY LEADER KIM IL SONG HAS CONDEMNED WHAT HE TERMED "OUTSIDE PRESSURE" UPON "FRATERNAL COUNTRIES."

AS REPORTED BY THE RADIO THIS MORNING, KIM IL SONG'S CONDEMNATION CAME IN A SPEECH MARKING THE 20TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE PROCLAMATION OF THE KOREAN PEOPLE'S DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC. THE RADIO DID NOT RPT NOT SAY WHEN HE MADE THE SPEECH.

IT QUOTED KIM IL SONG AS SAYING: "... FOR THE FINAL VICTORY OF SOCIALISM IT IS NECESSARY TO STRENGTHEN THE CLASS ALLIANCE OF THE SOCIALIST COUNTRIES, THE UNITY AND COHESION OF THE SOCIALIST CAMP WHOSE POWER MUST BECOME INVINCIBLE..."

"IF THE (COMMUNIST) PARTIES AND SOCIALIST COUNTRIES WANT REAL UNITY, THEY MUST ACT IN CONFORMITY WITH THE BASIC STANDARDS OF THEIR MUTUAL RELATIONS WHOSE MAIN CONTENT IN PRINCIPLE CONSISTS IN FULL EQUALITY, INDEPENDENCE, NON-INTERFERENCE WITH THE DOMESTIC AFFAIRS OF OTHER COUNTRIES, MUTUAL COOPERATION.

"TO CEMENT THE CLASS SOLIDARITY OF THE SOCIALIST COUNTRIES, ALL FRATERNAL COUNTRIES MUST RESPECT AND AID EACH OTHER SINCERELY ON A FOOTING OF EQUALITY. AT THE SAME TIME THEY MUST NOT RPT NOT RENOUNCE THEIR AUTONOMY UNDER OUTSIDE PRESSURE, NOR FOLLOW OTHER PARTIES AND COUNTRIES BLINDLY.

"IN LEADING REVOLUTION AND CONSTRUCTION, COMMUNISTS NEVER MUST DEPART FROM THE UNIVERSAL PROGRAM OF MARXISM-LENINISM, NOR MUST THEY COPY DOGMATICALLY THE EXPERIENCE OF SOME FRATERNAL COUNTRIES WITHOUT TAKING INTO ACCOUNT (THEIR) SOCIALIST PECULIARITIES..."
