

CS - INDIA PRO-MOSCOW COMMUNISTS WELCOME MOSCOW AGREEMENT

NEW DELHI, SEPT. 9, REUTER - INDIA'S PRO-MOSCOW COMMUNIST PARTY TODAY WELCOMED LAST MONTH'S MOSCOW AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE LEADERS OF THE SOVIET UNION AND CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

BUT IN A RESOLUTION ON CZECHOSLOVAKIA AFTER A 10-DAY MEETING, THE PARTY'S NATIONAL COUNCIL NEITHER CONDONED NOR CRITICISED THE WARSAW PACT INVASION.

IT CALLED FOR MOSCOW AND PRAGUE TO ENSURE SPEEDY AND EFFECTIVE IMPLEMENTATION OF THEIR RESPECTIVE OBLIGATIONS UNDER THE MOSCOW AGREEMENT, WHICH IT DESCRIBED AS "A WISE AND CONSTRUCTIVE STEP IN AN EXTREMELY DELICATE AND COMPLICATED SITUATION."

THE PARTY RESOLUTION EXTENDED WARM FRATERNAL SYMPATHIES AND SOLIDARITY WITH THE PEOPLE OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA IN THEIR STRUGGLE FOR FIRM DEFENCE OF SOCIALISM AND FOR SOLIDARITY OF THE SOCIALIST COMMUNITY.

COMMENTING ON THE INVASION, IT ACCUSED IMPERIALIST AND ANTI-SOCIALIST FORCES THROUGHOUT THE WORLD OF BUILDING UP A CAMPAIGN TO DISCREDIT THE SOVIET UNION, THE UNITY OF SOCIALIST COUNTRIES AND THE CAUSE OF COMMUNISM.
