

X/4 CS - GOVERNMENT PASSES LAW, APPOINTS DEPUTY MINISTERS

(RELEADS CN-119)

MUNICH, SEPT 9 (CMD)- THE CZECHOSLOVAK GOVERNMENT TODAY APPROVED A LAW WHICH SAYS THAT THE EXISTING COMPOSITION OF POLITICAL PARTIES AND SOCIAL ORGANIZATIONS IN THE COUNTRY FULLY CORRESPONDS WITH THE POLITICAL INTERESTS OF THE COUNTRY'S "SOCIALIST" SOCIETY.

RADIO PRAGUE TONIGHT REPORTED THAT THE LAW CONCERNS THE NATIONAL FRONT, CZECHOSLOVAKIA'S COMMUNIST-LED MASS ORGANIZATION.

THE GOVERNMENT WHICH MET UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF DEPUTY PREMIER LUBOMIR STROUGAL ALSO APPOINTED DEPUTY INTERIOR MINISTERS, THE RADIO SAID. IT GAVE NO RPT NO NAMES AND DID NOT RPT NOT SAY NOW MANY WERE NAMED.

DEALING WITH THE BILL ON THE NATIONAL FRONT, THE RADIO SAID "AS FAR AS THE SYSTEM OF POLITICAL PARTIES IS CONCERNED, IT IS CONSIDERED AS BEING CLOSED AND THAT IT IS NECESSARY TO USE AND DEVELOP ALL ITS POSSIBILITIES.

"THE LAW EXPRESSES THE PRINCIPLE THAT STATE BODIES CANNOT RPT NOT INTERFERE IN THE INTERNAL ARRANGEMENT OF THE NATIONAL FRONT WHICH IS AN EXPRESSION OF THE UNION OF NATIONS AND NATIONALITIES, SOCIAL SEGMENTS AND INTEREST GROUPS," THE RADIO SAID.

THE GOVERNMENT TODAY ALSO APPROVED A DIRECTIVE FOR THE PARTICIPATION OF CZECHOSLOVAK DELEGATIONS IN INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCES.
