

X/4 CS - RADIO APPEALS TO PEOPLE TO RETURN TO CSSR

MUNICH, SEPT 9 (CMD)- THE CZECHOSLOVAK RADIO TODAY BROADCAST AN APPEAL TO ALL CZECHOSLOVAKS NOW STAYING ABROAD NOT RPT NOT TO DELAY THEIR RETURN HOME.

THE APPEAL WHICH SAID THE SITUATION IN THE COUNTRY IS RETURNING TO NORMAL, WAS ISSUED BY THE CZECHOSLOVAK GOVERNMENT COMMITTEE FOR TOURIST TRAFFIC.

THE APPEAL BROADCAST OVER RADIO CZECHOSLOVAKIA'S INTERNATIONAL SERVICE IN CZECH SAID (TEXT):

"THE SECRETARIAT OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK GOVERNMENT COMMITTEE FOR TOURIST TRAFFIC TODAY APPEALED TO ALL CZECHOSLOVAK CITIZENS WHO ARE NOW ABROAD NOT TO DELAY THEIR RETURN HOME. MANY CZECHOSLOVAK CITIZENS ARE STILL DELAYING THEIR RETURN FOR REASONS OF INSECURITY AND ANXIETIES, BECAUSE THEY LACK TRUTHFUL INFORMATION ON THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE SITUATION IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

"THE SITUATION IN OUR COUNTRY IS RETURNING TO NORMAL. IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE APPEAL OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK STATE AND PARTY AUTHORITIES, ALL OUR CITIZENS ARE ENDEAVORING TO SPEEDILY RESTORE NORMAL ECONOMIC LIFE.

"THE GOVERNMENT COMMITTEE FOR TOURIST TRAFFIC APPEALS, THEREFORE, TO ALL CZECHOSLOVAK CITIZENS ABROAD TO SUPPORT THE EFFORTS OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK GOVERNMENT FOR THE CONSOLIDATION OF THE NATIONAL ECONOMY AND ASKS THEM TO RETURN AS QUICKLY AS POSSIBLE TO THEIR WORK PLACES."
