THIS APPEARED TO BE A REPOSE TO SANDOR BARCS, VICE PRESIDENT OF THE HUNGARIAN FEDERATION, WHO IN HIS PROTEST LAST WEEK CHARGED THAT THE UNION WAS PERMITTING ITSELF TO BE GOVERNED BY POLITICAL MOTIVES, "" AN ATTITUDE WHICH CARRIES WITHIN IT THE SEED OF DISSOLUTION OF THE UNION.""
