

X/4 CURT - NICULESCU-MIZIL ON RUMANIAN-ITALIAN PARTY IDEAS

BUCHAREST, SEPT. 9 (CMD) - RUMANIAN EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEMBER PAUL NICULESCU-MIZIL SAID TODAY THAT THE RUMANIAN LEADERSHIP HAD HELD TALKS WITH VISITING ITALIAN POLITBURO MEMBER GIAN CARLO PAJETTA ON "PROBLEMS LINKED TO THE CURRENT SITUATION IN THE INTERNATIONAL WORKING CLASS MOVEMENT; THE ACTUAL INTERNATIONAL SITUATION."

WITH PAJETTA AT HIS SIDE, HE TOLD A MEETING AT THE BUCHAREST MACHINE TOOL WORKS: "I AM PLEASED TO INFORM YOU THAT DURING THESE DISCUSSIONS WE FOUND A SIMILAR WAY OF THINKING," AGERPRES REPORTED.

HE SAID THAT "THIS COMMON WAY OF CONSIDERING THE COMMUNIST AND WORKING CLASS MOVEMENT" SPRANG FROM THE COMMON PREOCCUPATION OF THE ITALIAN AND RUMANIAN COMMUNIST PARTIES "OF DOING EVERYTHING IN THIS DIFFICULT SITUATION FOR THE RELATIONS BETWEEN SOCIALIST COUNTRIES TO HELP OVERCOME THESE DIFFICULTIES."

BOTH PARTIES, HE SAID, BELIEVED THAT EVERYTHING SHOULD BE DONE "TO FIND A PATH TO SOLVE THESE PROBLEMS IN THE SPIRIT OF EXPANDING AND STRENGTHENING THE RELATIONS OF INTERNATIONALIST SOLIDARITY BETWEEN THE COMMUNIST AND WORKERS PARTIES."

NICULESCU-MIZIL SAID THAT BOTH PARTIES STARTED FROM THE ASSUMPTION THAT EACH COMMUNIST PARTY WAS THE VOICE AND THE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE WORKING CLASS AND THE PEOPLE OF ITS OWN COUNTRY.

"AT THE SAME TIME, WE PROCEED FROM THE IDEA THAT THE FORCE OF THE COMMUNIST AND WORKERS PARTIES LIES IN THE CAPACITY FOR BROADENING THE ROAD TOWARDS DEVELOPING RELATIONS OF SOLIDARITY BETWEEN DIFFERENT COMMUNIST AND WORKERS PARTIES; OF FINDING POSSIBILITIES FOR STRENGTHENING THE UNITY OF COMMUNIST AND WORKERS PARTIES."

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
