X/4 CS - TWO NEW DEPUTY INTERIOR MINISTERS APPOINTED

(AMPLIFIES CN-145)

PRAGUE, SEPT 9 (CMD)- THE CZECHOSLOVAK GOVERNMENT TODAY APPOINTED DR. FRANTISEK VASEK AND DR. JAROSLAV RYBAR DEPUTY MINISTERS OF THE INTERIOR, CETEKA REPORTED TONIGHT.

(EARLIER TONIGHT RADIO PRAGUE SAID THE GOVERNMENT HAS APPOINTED DEPUTY MINISTERS, BUT GAVE NO RPT NO NAMES AND DID NOT RPT NOT SAY HOW MANY APPOINTMENTS WERE MADE.)

THE GOVERNMENT ALSO DISCUSSED THE SITUATION IN THE COUNTRY AND QUESTIONS CONNECTED WITH THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE MOSCOW AGREEMENTS.)

CETEKA SAID THE GOVERNMENT ESTABLISHED A SLOVAK DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR MINISTRY.

STANISLAV RAZL, MINISTER OF THE CHEMICAL INDUSTRY, WAS APPOINTED CHAIRMAN OF THE COMMISSION FOR ECONOMIC QUESTIONS CONNECTED WITH THE PLANNED FEDERALIZATION OF THE COUNTRY, AND MEMBER OF THE ECONOMIC COUNCIL.

FRANTISEK VLASAK, MINISTER OF ECONOMIC PLANNING, WAS APPOINTED CHAIRMAN OF THE NATIONAL ECONOMIC COMMISSION OF THE ECONOMIC COUNCIL.

THE GOVERNMENT HEARD A DETAILED REPORT ON PROGRESS IN THE NORMALIZATION OF THE ECONOMIC AND PUBLIC LIFE.

IN THIS CONNECTION, THE GOVERNMENT DISCUSSED QUESTIONS CONCERNING THE OBSERVANCE OF LEGALITY, AS WELL AS WITH OTHER QUESTIONS AND TASKS ENSUING FROM THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE MOSCOW AGREEMENTS, CETEKA SAID.
