X/4 CS - ADN CRITICIZES LACK OF IDEOLOGICAL WORK

PRAGUE, SEPT 10 (CMD)- THE EAST GERMAN PRESS AGENCY, ADN, CHARGED LAST NIGHT THAT LITTLE WAS BEING DONE IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA TO STRUGGLE AGAINST THE "IDEOLOGICAL CONFUSION", THERE.

IN A REPORT BY AN UNNAMED CORRESPONDENT IN PRAGUE THE AGENCY CLAIMED THAT THE LACK OF KNOWLEDGE BY THE CZECHOSLOVAK POPULATION ABOUT THE MOSCOW AGREEMENTS AND "OTHER DOCUMENTS" WAS CREATING A BASIS FOR RUMOR-MONGERING BY "ANTI-SOCIALIST FORCES."

ADN NOTED THAT MOST OF THE PAPERS IN THE COUNTRY HAD NOT RPT NOT YET PUBLISHED THE TEXT OF THE MOSCOW COMMUNIQUE.

ADN THEN REFERRED TO RECENTLY DISTRIBUTED LEAFLETS CONTAINING AN ALLEGED TEXT OF THE MOSCOW AGREEMENTS. THAT HAD BEEN DENIED BY CETEKA.

"EVEN FOLLOWING THIS, THE C.S.S.R. POPULATION WAS STILL NOT RPT NOT INFORMED ABOUT THE COMMUNIQUE ON THE MOSCOW TALKS....." ADN SAID.

IT QUOTED ANOTHER RUMOR INVENTED BY "COUNTER-REVOLUTIONARY FORCES" IN WESTERN BOHEMIA ABOUT ALLEGED PLANS BY FOREIGN TROOPS TO CONFISCATE FLATS AND WEEKEND HOUSES OF THE POPULATION, AND SAID IT ALSO BEEN DENIED.
