

CS -- MORNING INTRO - SOVIET ATTACKS

MUNICH, SEPT 10 (CNR)-THE SOVIET UNION HAS CONTINUED ITS ASSAULT ON THE CZECHOSLOVAK PRESS.

THE SOVIET COMMUNIST PARTY PAPER, PRAVDA, COMPLAINED MONDAY THAT CZECHOSLOVAK PAPERS WERE PAINTING A FALSE PICTURE OF THE SITUATION IN THEIR COUNTRY, WHILE THE PRESS AGENCY, TASS, ACCUSED CERTAIN UN-NAMED ORGANS OF CONTINUING TO SPEAK FROM AN ANTI-SOCIALIST STANDPOINT.

THE PRAVDA ATTACK CLAIMED THE CZECHOSLOVAK PRESS WAS TRYING TO PAINT A PICTURE OF ALMOST TOTAL INTERNAL POLITICAL WELL-BEING.

PAPERS WERE CONVEYING THE WRONG IDEA THAT DANGER FROM RIGHT-WING, ANTI-SOCIALIST FORCES DID NOT RPT NOT EXIST, PRAVDA SAID.

THE SOVIET PAPER ALSO CLAIMED THAT A PAMPHLET CIRCULATING IN THE MORAVIAN CITY OF BRNO CALLED FOR THE PHYSICAL ANNIHILATION OF CZECHOSLOVAK COMMUNISTS AND SABOTAGE OF THE COUNTRY'S PLANNED RETURN TO NORMAL AND URGED THE WITHDRAWAL OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA FROM THE WARSAW PACT AND THE SOCIALIST COMMUNITY.

THE TASS ATTACK ON THE CZECHOSLOVAK PRESS SINGLED OUT THE OSTRAVA DISTRICT PAPER, NOVA SVOBODA, ACCUSING IT OF SYSTEMATICALLY PUBLISHING MATERIAL AIMED AT INCITING ANIMOSITY TOWARDD WHAT TASS CALLED THE ALLIED SOCIALIST COUNTRIES.

TASS ALSO WARNED OF ELEMENTS THAT TRIED TO USE THE CZECHOSLOVAK PRESS FOR ANTI-POPULAR AND ANTI-SOCIALIST AIMS. THE AGENCY WARNED NEWSPAPERS THAT OPENLY HOSTILE STATEMENTS, CAMOUFLAGED ATTACKS AND POLISHED INSINUATIONS WOULD NOT GO UNNOTICED.

RADIO MOSCOW HAS DENIED THAT THE DECISION TO INVADE CZECHOSLOVAKIA WAS MADE ON THE BASIS OF FAULTY INFORMATION.

THE BROADCAST SAID THAT OPENLY COUNTER-REVOLUTIONARY, ANTI-SOCIALIST ACTIVITY IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA AFTER THE SOVIET-CZECHOSLOVAK AGREEMENT OF AUGUST 2 PROVED THAT ALL INFORMATION WAS CORRECT.
