

C/S - PRAVDA ATTACKS "DENIGRATORS"

MOSCOW, SEPT 10, REUTER -

THE COMMUNIST PARTY NEWSPAPER PRAVDA CHARGED TODAY THAT "DENIGRATORS OF SOCIALISM, CONSPIRATORS AND INCITERS" WERE STILL WORKING IN CZECHOSLOVAK RADIO, TELEVISION AND PRESS ORGANS, AND HAD SUPPORT FROM SOME GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS.

IN A REPORT FROM A CORRESPONDENT IN BRATISLAVA, A. MURZIN, PRAVDA SAID CZECHOSLOVAK NEWSPAPERS "ARE STRIVING DIRECTLY AND BETWEEN THE LINES TO CONVINCE THEIR READERS THAT THERE WAS AND IS NO COUNTER-REVOLUTION IN THE COUNTRY."

AIM OF THIS, PRAVDA ADDED, WAS TO SHOW THAT COUNTER-REVOLUTION "IS AN INVENTION OF THE ALLIED (WARSAW PACT) POWERS AND A PRETEXT TO INVADE THE COUNTRY AND FORCE ON IT THEIR OWN WAY OF THINKING."

BUT, SAID PRAVDA, "OUR SOLDIERS, NOW THEY ARE IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA AND HAVE READ THE PROVOCATIVE ARTICLES AND LEAFLETS, HAVE UNDERSTOOD MORE CLEARLY THAN EVER THAT THE COUNTER-REVOLUTIONARIES ARE NOT ONLY THOSE WHO BORE ARMS BUT ALSO THOSE WHO DAILY FILLED THE AIR AND THE PAGES OF NEWSPAPERS WITH SLANDER AND ANTI-SOVIETISM, THOSE WHO WANTED TO MAKE OUR TWO PEOPLES QUARREL.

IN A FRONT-PAGE EDITORIAL, PRAVDA SAID TODAY RELATIONS OF MUTUAL RESPECT, EQUALITY, MUTUAL AID AND SUPPORT WERE TYPICAL OF ALL SPHERES OF SOVIET-CZECHOSLOVAK TIES.

THE MOSCOW TALKS, HELD AFTER THE AUGUST 20 WARSAW PACT MOVE INTO CZECHOSLOVAKIA, "REASSERTED THE FRIENDSHIP AND BROTHERHOOD" OF THE TWO PEOPLES AND THE TWO PARTIES, PRAVDA ADDED.
