VISITS - STEWART: BRITAIN STILL READY TO WORK FOR PEACE (RELEADS CN 15)
(EMBARGOED FOR AUTOMATIC RELEASE AT 1230 MT TODAY)

BUCHAREST, SEPTEMBER 10 (REUTER) - BRITISH FOREIGN SECRETARY
MICHAEL STEWART SAID HERE TODAY BRITAIN REMAINED DETERMINED
TO CREATE THE RIGHT ATMOSPHERE FOR PERMANENT PEACE IN EUROPE.

MR STEWART, IN A SPEECH PREPARED FOR DELIVERY
AT A LUNCHEON HE WAS GIVING IN HONOUR OF RUMANIAN FOREIGN
MINISTER CORNELIU MANESCU, SAID THAT THE PROBLEMS OF EUROPE
WERE CENTRAL TO THE DISCUSSIONS THEY HAD BEEN HOLDING HERE.

HE ADDED: "THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT HAVE BEEN MAKING
STRENUOUS EFFORTS IN RECENT YEARS TO ESTABLISH A BASIS FOR
DETENTE IN EUROPE. EVERY DAY, WE SEE HOW ESSENTIAL THIS IS."

HE THEN CONTINUED: "IN SPITE OF THE UNDOUBTED SETBACK
CAUSED BY RECENT EVENTS, THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT REMAIN
DETERMINED TO CREATE THE RIGHT ATMOSPHERE FOR PERMANENT PEACE
IN EUROPE."

HE CONTINUED: "IT MUST BE RECOGNISED THAT, ON
SOME OF THE GREAT INTERNATIONAL ISSUES, OUR OUTLOOK IS DIFFERENT
FROM YOURS.
