"THE WAR IN VIETNAM IS AN EXAMPLE. BUT HERE IT CAN BE SAID THAT OUR TWO COUNTRIES SHARE A DEEP CONCERN TO SEE AN END TO THE TRAGIC WAR AND A NEGOTIATED SETTLEMENT AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.

"EVEN WHERE OUR ANALYSIS OF INTERNATIONAL PROBLEMS DIFFERS, WE AGREE ON THE FUNDAMENTAL PRINCIPLE THAT THESE PROBLEMS ARE CAPABLE OF SOLUTION WITHOUT ANY RESORT TO FORCE AND THAT IT IS UP TO ALL STATES TO HELP TO RESOLVE PROBLEMS BY PEACEFUL MEANS-BY NEGOTIATIONS, BY ARBITRATION OR BY CONCILIATION.

"THIS COMMON APPROACH TO THE PROBLEM OF SETTling DISPUTES BY PEACEFUL MEANS IS ONE REASON WHY I HAVE BEEN LOOKING FORWARD TO MY DISCUSSIONS HERE IN BUCHAREST."
