X/4 C/S - VLTAVA DEFINES "NORMALIZATION"

MUNICH, SEPT 10 (CMD) - THE SOVIET-SUPPORTED RADIO STATION VLTAVA HAS SAID ONE WOULD BE ABLE TO SPEAK ABOUT "A REAL NORMALIZATION IN THE SPIRIT OF THE MOSCOW AGREEMENT" ONLY AFTER THE "WORKERS AND PEASANT POWER IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA" STANDS FIRMLY.

IN A COMMENTARY YESTERDAY, THE RADIO ADDED THAT ONE WOULD BE ABLE TO SPEAK ABOUT A NORMALIZATION OF THE SITUATION "WHEN THE POINT IS COMPLETELY CLEAR, AT LEAST AMONG THE PARTY MEMBERS, CONCERNING THE EXISTENCE OF THE CLASSES, THE EXISTENCE OF THE CLASS STRUGGLE AND THE NECESSITY OF THE DICTATORSHIP OF THE PROLETARIAT."

THE BROADCAST SAID ONE WOULD BE ABLE TO SPEAK ABOUT A REAL NORMALIZATION WHEN THE COUNTERREVOLUTION, NO RPT NO MATTER WHEN AND WHERE IT MIGHT APPEAR, "IMMEDIATELY FEELS THE STRENGTH OF THE LEADING PARTY OF THE COUNTRY AND OF THE WORKING CLASS AND IS DEFEATED."
