

X/4 C/S - C/S GETS RESPONSIBILITY FOR HER AIR SPACE (RELEADS CN 16)

MUNICH, SEPT 10 (CMD) -- RADIO PRAGUE SAID TODAY THAT ACCORDING TO INFORMATION FROM THE CZECHOSLOVAK AIRLINE, CZECHOSLOVAKIA "TOOK OVER THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR HER AIR-SPACE YESTERDAY."

THE RADIO ADDED THAT THE AIRLINES ALSO RESUMED SERVICE ON ITS INTERNATIONAL ROUTES.

BEGINNING TODAY, THE SCHEDULE OF THE AIRLINES CONCERNING FOREIGN ROUTES "IS VALID TO THE FULL EXTENT WITH THE EXEPTION OF THE ROUTES TO ROME, AMSTERDAM AND BRUSSELS. FOREIGN (AIR) TRANSPORT ORGANIZATIONS ARE SCHEDULED TO RESUME OPERATIONS TODAY," THE RADIO SAID.

INDIVIDUAL TRAVEL AGENCIES "TRY TO CARRY OUT THEIR PLANNED FALL TOURS," THE RADIO ADDED.

TRIPS TO VIENNA AND THE UNITED ARAB REPUBLIC WILL ALSO CONTINUE, RADIO PRAGUE REPORTED.

IT SAID THAT ACCORDING TO INFORMATION FROM AN OFFICIAL OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK PASSPORT ADMINISTRATION, VISAS FOR TRIPS OF CZECHOSLOVAK CITIZENS ABROAD "ARE BEING GRANTED NORMALLY, THIS MEANS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CONDITIONS SET BY THE LAW."

AS FAR AS THE VISITS OF FOREIGN TOURISTS TO CZECHOSLOVAKIA ARE CONCERNED THE RESUMPTION OF THE TRAFFIC "IS VERY SLOW," THE RADIO DECLARED.
