MOSCOW, SEPT 10 (CMD) -- CZECHOSLOVAK PREMIER OLDŘICH CERNIK LEFT MOSCOW BY PLANE FOR HOME TODAY AFTER "SUCCESSFUL" TALKS WITH SOVIET PREMIER ALEXEI KOSYGIN, TASS REPORTED.

TASS SAID KOSYGIN, FIRST DEPUTY PREMIER KIRIL MAZUROV, DEPUTY PREMIERS NIKOLAI BAIBAKOV AND VLADIMIR KIRILLIN AND OTHER OFFICIALS SAW CERNIK OFF FROM VNUKOVO AIRPORT.

A GUARD OF HONOR WAS LINED UP AT THE AIRPORT AND THE NATIONAL ANTHEMS OF THE TWO COUNTRIES WERE PLAYED.
