X/4 C/S - BEJCEK SAYS FOREIGN TROOPS NEED EXPLANATION

MUNICH, SEPT 10 (CMD)- THE SECRETARY OF A BOHEMIAN DISTRICT PARTY COMMITTEE TODAY TOLD A RADIO PRAGUE AUDIENCE ABOUT THE NECESSITY OF "CONVINCING" THE FOREIGN TROOPS OF THE INCORRECTNESS OF THEIR ARRIVAL IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

THE SECRETARY OF THE Kladno District Party Committee Karel Bejcek said in an interview carried by Radio Prague that the Kladno (near Prague) steel workers, minors and also the other population "stand firmly behind our party, our government and national assembly representatives."

Bejcek said "at the current period, we have chosen a new tactic" regarding the attitude towards the foreign troops, "we turn our attention to the convincing both the foreign soldiers and officers of the incorrectness of their arrival, of our truth."

He said those Czechoslovaks who contacted the troops were subject of "accusations," and slanders."

To avoid this, "we want to organize discussions" among the population in order to convince the people. That this is "incorrect," he added.
