X/4 C/S -- C/S TOURISTS TO GDR BANNED IN SOME AREAS

MUNICH, SEPT 10 (CMD) -- RADIO PRAGUE REPORTED TODAY THAT THE CZECHOSLOVAK TOURISTS TO EAST GERMANY ARE BANNED FROM STAYING IN SOME AREAS THERE.

THE RADIO SAID CZECHOSLOVAKS TRAVELLING TO EAST GERMANY ARE ALLOWED TO CROSS THE BORDER POINTS AT VARNSDORF AND HRENSKO, BUT NOTED THAT THE CZECHOSLOVAK-EAST GERMAN CROSSING POINT AT CINOVEC IS CLOSED FOR THEM BY EAST GERMAN BORDER GUARDS.

THE RADIO SAID CZECHOSLOVAKS MAY GO ON TOURISTS TRIPS, VISITS OR HOLIDAYS TO EAST GERMANY, BUT "MUST NOT RPT NOT DO SHOPPING IN THE GERMAN DEMOCRATIC^T REPUBLIC."

THE RADIO ALSO SAID THAT CZECHOSLOVAK CITIZENS ARE NOT RPT NOT ALLOWED TO STAY "IN THE AREAS WHICH ARE SITUATED SOUTH OF THE HIGHWAY LEADING FROM POLAND TO THE BORDERS WITH THE GERMAN FEDERAL REPUBLIC."
