X/4 C/S - 2D ADD CERNIK PROPOSES (CN 177) XXX FOODSTUFFS

THE OFFICIAL CZECHOSLOVAK NEWS AGENCY SAID FOREIGN TRADE MINISTER VACLAV VALES, WHO PARTICIPATED IN THE MOSCOW TALKS, TERMED THE RESULTS OF THE TALKS "AN IMPORTANT CONTRIBUTION TOWARD SETTTLING CZECHOSLOVAK ECONOMIC PROBLEMS."

VALES WAS FURTHER QUOTED AS SAYING THE TALKS "OPEN THE ROAD TO FURTHER NEGOTIATIONS. THEY TOUCH UPON OUR MOST FUNDAMENTAL INTERESTS IN THE ECONOMIC SPHERE."

THE OTHER CZECHOSLOVAK DELEGATE TO THE MOSCOW TALKS, DEPUTY PREMIER FRANTISEK HAMOUZ, RETURNED TO PRAGUE TODAY WITH CERNIK AND VALES.

CETKA SAID THEY WERE WELCOMED BY DEPUTY PREMIERS GUSTAV HUSAK AND PETER COLOTKA. THE SOVIET AMBASSADOR TO PRAGUE, S.V. CHERVONENKO, WAS ALSO PRESENT, CETKA REPORTED. (CETKA, SEPT. 10)
